My name and mobile number	
 A photo of my pet and details including their name, age, feeding schedule, temperament, likes and dislikes, suitability to children/other animals, whether they live indoors/outdoors, etc. 	
 Details of my animal's current vet alongside copies of medical records, proof of vaccination records and/or microchip details 	
8. Do I have my pet's leash, collar, ID tags and carriers (or crates) available, in case they need to be transported?	
9. Do I have a quick contact list I can give to any temporary pet carer in my wallet and on my fridge and/or with other pet documentation?
