THINGS WE GRATEFULLY ACCEPT

- Accessories: handbags, hats + jewellery
- Beds and cost (**conditions apply**, see over the page or check in-store)
- Clothing - women's, men's + kid's
- Dress up clothes
- Electrical goods (**conditions apply**, see over the page or check in-store)
- Games of any kind (kids + adult games)
- Homewares + bric-a-brac
- Manchester
- Small furniture (Kidman Park only)
- Toys, books, CDs + DVDs



THINGS WE DON'T ACCEPT

- Anything broken, chipped, scratched or with missing parts/pieces
- Doonas, quilts, pillows
- Mattresses
- Soiled or damaged clothing
- Underwear, bathers



While there are some items we unfortunately can't accept, others may be accepted if they meet certain conditions. The following pages outline what we can and can't take to help guide your donation.

Items accepted with conditions

- Basketball rings/backboards [must meet safety/anchoring standards]
- Beanbags (without filling) [must have child safety warning label]
- Beds and Cots [must meet safety standards; check for recalls]
- Bicycles/mini-motorbikes/exercise bikes [only allowed if in working, safe condition]
- Blinds, curtains, window fittings [corded types must comply with safety standards]
- Bunk beds [must meet strict construction/safety standards]
- Electrical items [only allowed if tested/tagged and compliant]**
- Highchairs [must meet safety standards; check for recalls]
- Prams, strollers [must meet safety standards; check for recalls]
- Soccer goals (moveable) [must meet anti-tip safety standards]
- Sunglasses/fashion spectacles [must meet labelling and UV protection standards]



**Electrical items not accepted

- Appliances with damaged Teflon bases (e.g. irons) [Potential chemical/toxic hazard]
- Bar heaters [fire hazard; not compliant with safety standards]
- Dirty or damaged electrical items [cannot be tested; hygiene/safety risk]
- Double wire cords (non-earthed) [not compliant with modern electrical safety]
- Electric blankets [fire and safety risk]
- International plugs [may not meet Australian standards]
- Items that have been rewired (DIY) [non-compliant; risk of electrocution/fire]
- Old cords lacking correct insulation [fire/electrocution hazard]
- Portable fan heaters with damaged safety pads [unsafe for resale]
- Rusty or unhygienic electrical items [not suitable for resale; safety concern]

Items not accepted

- Animal handling gear (e.g. shock/choke collars) [prohibited under internal policy]
- Aquatic/flotation toys [safety regulation]
- Baby bath aids, walkers, sleep sacks, cot bumpers [prohibited and/or safety risks]
- Balloon blowing kits [not allowed under ACCC standards]
- Bicycle helmets [not permitted due to lifespan/safety issues]
- Child car restraints [prohibited unless certified]
- Clothing/textiles without care labels [mandatory care labelling required]
- Cosmetics without ingredient labels [illegal to sell]
- Decorative alcohol-fuelled devices [prohibited due to fire risk]
- Disposable cigarette lighters [safety hazard]
- Elastic luggage straps [illegal if missing required warning label]
- Electrical items [unsafe, rewired, foreign plugs]
- Event tickets, virtual currency, lottery tickets
- Fire extinguishers (all types)
- Firearms, knives (excl. butter knives), slingshots
- Food/perishables with no labels or expired [safety and legal concerns]
- Gift cards (except RSPCA)
- Hot water bottles
- Mattresses, used pillows/quilts/protectors [hygiene and safety concerns]
- Medical devices [prohibited]
- Offensive/pornographic materials
- Pet food/shampoos (unless unopened)
- Pet medications
- Religious books/items (except jewellery)
- Self-balancing scooters/quad biked
- Tobacco products, alcohol [illegal to sell]
- Toys with magnets/lead or projectile features
- Used baby toys (dirty, damaged, under 36 months)
- Used bottles/pacifiers (not in packaging) [hygiene/safety concerns]
